- **Day Returns** Available Monday-Friday before 09:30
- **Cheap Day Return** Available Monday-Friday from 09:30 and all day Saturday, Sunday & Bank Holidays
- **Single Tickets:** Metro journeys must be completed within 90 minutes of time of purchase
- **Return Tickets:** Outward Metro journey must be completed within 90 minutes, return journey by the end of that day.

Please note child fares cannot be purchased on the Metro after 22:00.
 Centro Concessionary Travel Passes are accepted for travel on the Metro from 09:30 weekdays until the end of daytime services and all day at weekends and Bank Holidays.

Conditions Of Carriage

Passengers must pay correct fare and retain ticket or hold a valid travelcard or other pass. Failure to do so will result in the imposition of a "standard fare" of £10 regardless of distance travelled.

Full conditions are available for inspection at National Express offices and travel shops.

Do Not Distract The Driver

National Express staff have the right to work without fear of assault or intimidation. National Express will actively prosecute anybody who does not respect this right.

Respect The Conductor

Respect the rights of the conductor to work without fear or intimidation.

Passengers Must Not

- Put feet on seats
- Smoke, including e-cigarettes. - A fixed penalty notice of £50 will be issued to individuals who commit the offence of smoking in no-smoking premises or prosecution and a fine of up to £200
- Eat or drink whilst on board
- Play audio equipment or annoy other passengers
- Wilfully damage or deface any part of the vehicle
- Bring bicycles onto the tram
- Bring dogs onto the tram (other than Guide or Hearing dogs)
- Allow dogs on seats
- Spit
- Obstruct gangways with luggage etc
- Leave litter
